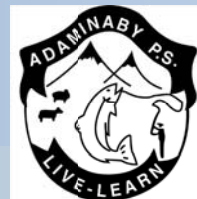

Principal's Message

A hot topic this week at school has been Out of Bounds areas. Students have been playing in areas that have been designated as 'out of bounds'.

Teachers have spent time explaining to students, areas that are inappropriate to play in and the reasons that they may be unsafe. Some areas have poor visibility for teachers to supervise children playing, or may be unsafe due to long grass etc. Teachers have also explained that if there is a reason to go into these areas during school times, they need to ask for permission from the teacher on duty.

We have also clarified with students the rules about playing on the oval during recess and lunch. This will be at the discretion of the teacher on duty. Students need to check with the teacher before going out onto the oval. The main reason for this is so that the teacher knows that they are in that area and can then position themselves in a good spot for supervision.

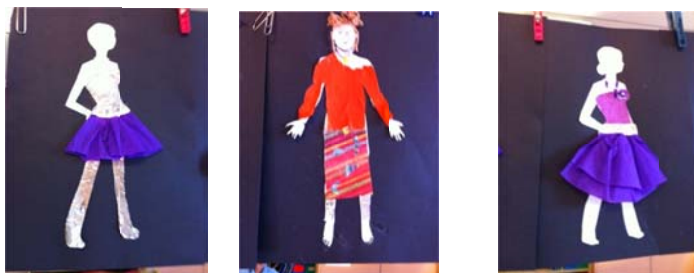
