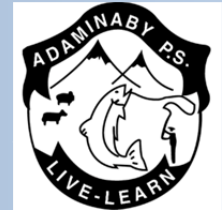

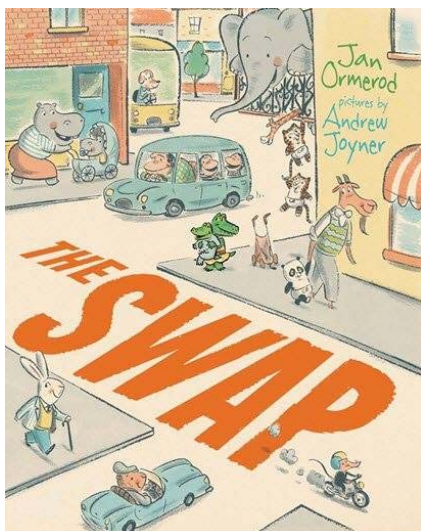
Book Week

It's Book Week. Here are some of the winning books that you may like to look out for:

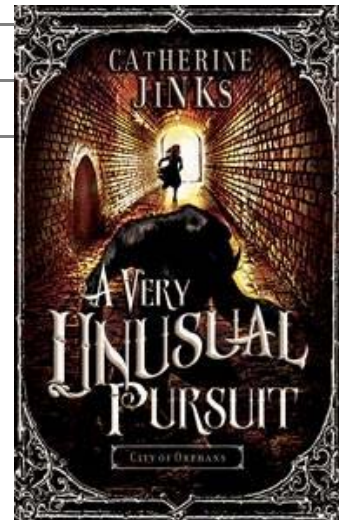
Picture Book of the Year
